This might be your school, church, sports organisation. You need your own bank account, or to have the support of someone who has a bank account. Support from a referee is encouraged.

## IDEA Workshop 1: Wednesday 12 November, 4 – 6pm, Ngapuhi Iwi Social Services

**Information:** the purpose of the fund is to support YOU (Kaikohe youth) to achieve or express their aspirations in the field of sport, culture, education, or personal/whanau/community development.

### Projects and activities applied for need to:

- develop skills in decision-making and leadership;
- involve YOU in decision-making and leadership responsibility;
- respond to a need in the community identified by YOU;
- support YOU to be engaged in and contribute to your community;
- benefit young people aged 12 to 18 years old;
- have a set date by which the project or activity will be complete.

**Decisions subject to approval:** Decisions will be made by a Kaikohe Aspirations Fund panel including youth. All decisions subject to approval by Te Pae Aronga Taitamariki.

## IDEA WORKSHOPS:

**These workshops will support you develop ideas, write applications for funding and other purposes, and provide information about funding that is available to you in Kaikohe.**

**Note: successful applicants will be required to report back to discuss their completed projects. The terms of reference document sets out all the rules of the fund, we recommend reading it**
