Yet, through the settlement process they are being talked over and generally being silenced by bad behaviour.</p> <p>Urbans are 75% of Ngāpuhi, 65,000 in Tāmaki alone, therefore must be represented on any Ngāpuhi representative model.</p> | <p>As per Maranga Mai - TKT do not want any of these groups represented on any Ngāpuhi representative model.</p> <p>TKT approach is that all Ngāpuhi must come back through Hapū at home if they want to be involved.</p> | |



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| | | <p>Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi-Ō-Ngāpuhi represents those who do not know their Hapū. It has the most comprehensive Ngāpuhi database in the world. It is the Mandated Iwi Organisation that speaks on behalf of Ngāpuhi katoa and the only Ngāpuhi entity with a Mandate to manage our Fisheries asset.</p> <p>Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi-Ō-Ngāpuhi is the only source of funding if Ngāpuhi need to litigate against the Crown for any reason.</p> | | |
